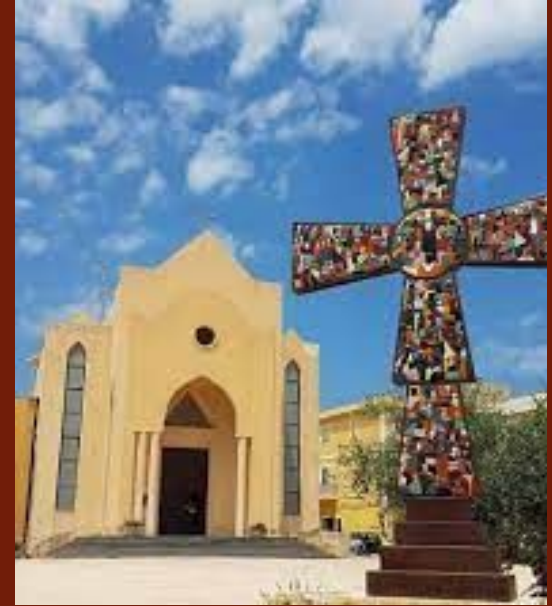
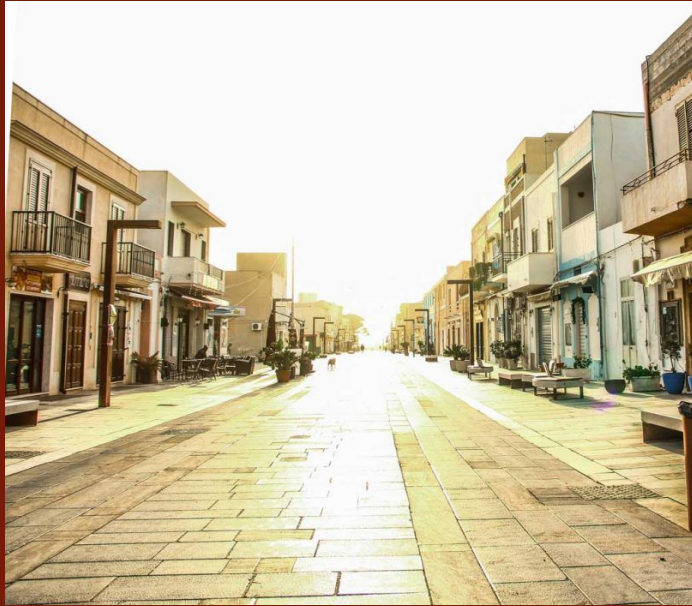
## RABBIT ISLAND :

The Rabbit Island is a beach located on the southwest coast of Lampedusa. It was elected by TripAdvisor users as the most beautiful beach in the world in 2013, in Europe and Italy in 2014 and 2015. There the turtles *Caretta Caretta* lay their eggs.

# THE SCHOOL IN LAMPEDUSA



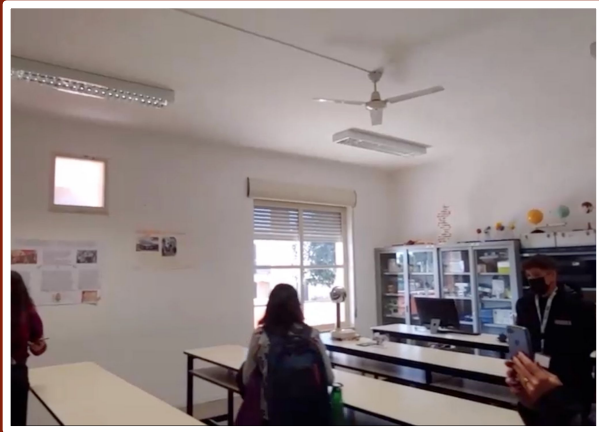
